Our Artist in Residence, Yvonne Baines, has been working with schools on a brilliant art project where students have made these awesome little monsters!

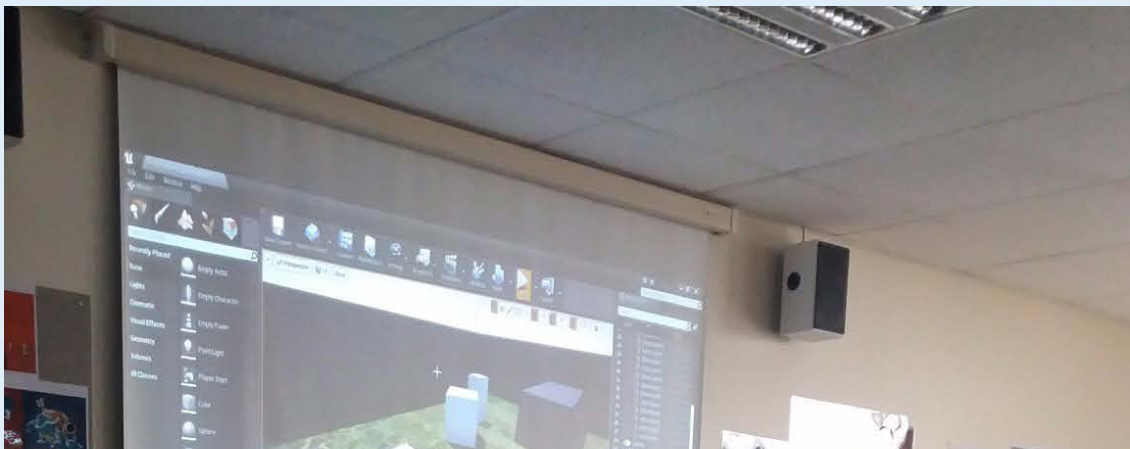
There is still an opportunity to get involved with this and is open to younger students too. Stay tuned for the upcoming **exhibition date!**

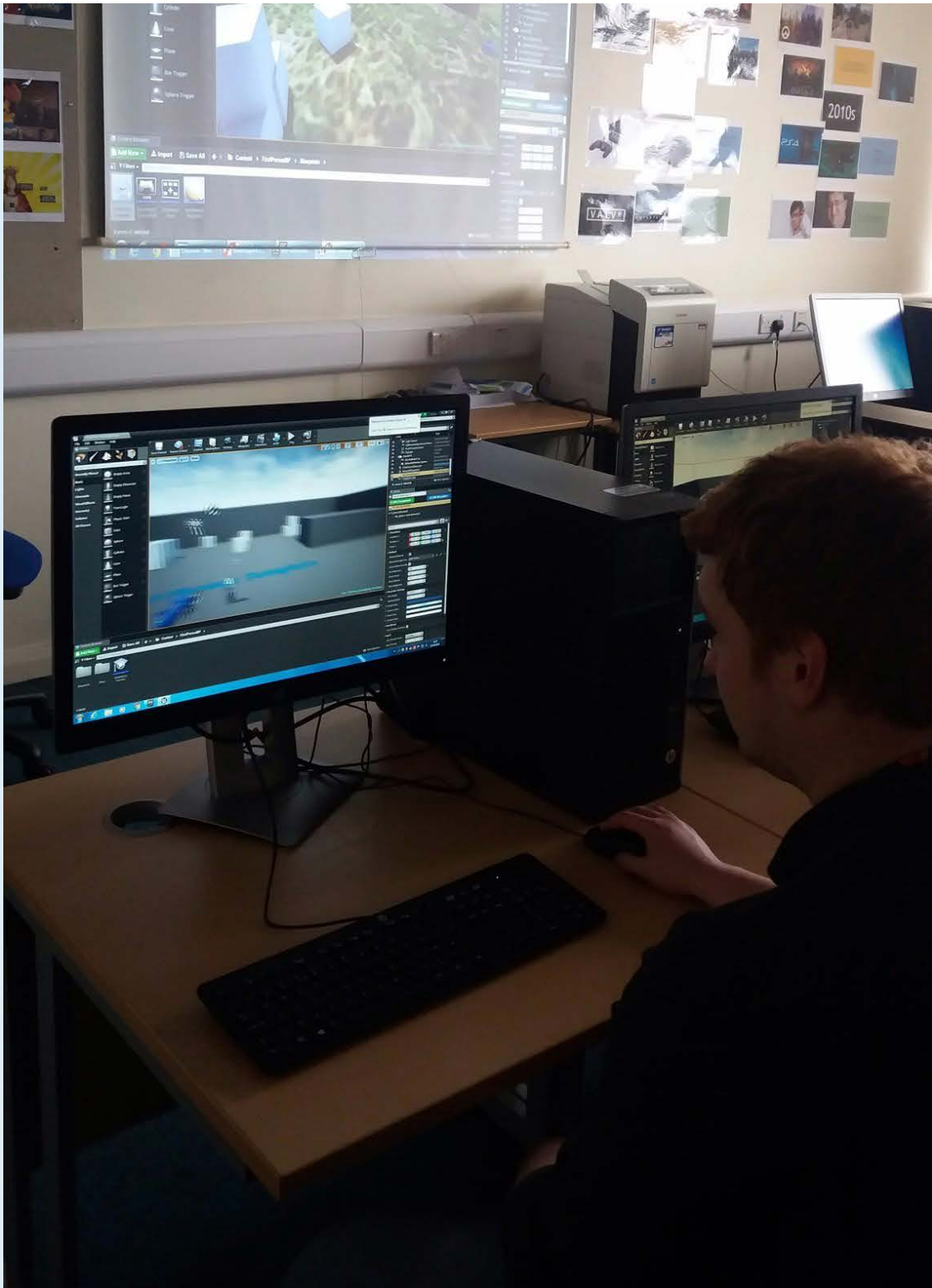


STEM Week!

We have started to plan these for some of the schools we are working with for June / July. These are extremely useful for year 10 students who will be looking to start making their applications soon!

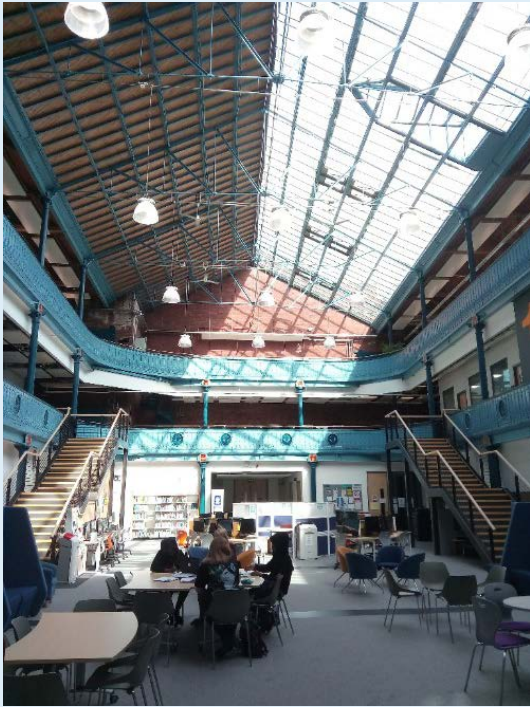
