

Wednesday Workshop | Task 08 | 03 June 2020

This week we have a casting workshop, here we have used a banana but you could also try different objects such as a bottle or an orange. Just make sure they have a simple outline!



Step 01. You will need your fruit, cling film, masking tape, scissors and a sharp blade to cut the cast at the end



Step 02. Your first layer needs to be cling film, make sure you get it as smooth as possible and it completely covers the banana. Then alternate layers using the masking tape so you will have 5 of each.



Step 03. Your last layer needs to be tape as it is easier to cut through. The layers should be smooth and they will hold the shape when you remove the fruit.



Step 04. Now we need to take the fruit out by making a cut at the top and running along one side. Do not cut towards yourself, make sure you are safe when doing this and do not rush.



Step 05. When you've made a cut through all the layers you can take the banana out. Tape up the cast using the masking tape and now you have your cast!



Step 06. If you have paint you could try decorating your fruit so it looks more life like.
