Here we have 'Still Life With Jug' by painter Paul Cézanne, who was preoccupied with still life, and would paint the same objects. He believed that conventional perspective, which uses a single viewpoint, did not accurately reflect the way that we perceive the world. In this painting, he combined several viewpoints of the fat-bellied jug and fruit. Like many of his works, it was left unfinished.
