If you already have a Level 3 qualification and earn below £19,305 (West Yorkshire only), you may qualify for a second Level 3 course. **Contact us to find out if you are eligible.**

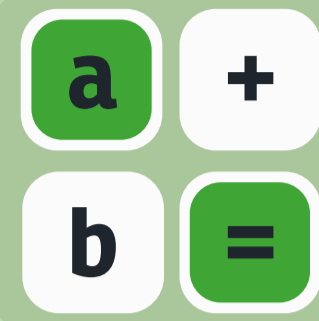

Many courses may be free if you are 19+ and any of the following applies:



You are under 24 and have an Education Health and Care Plan from your local authority

You are wanting to join a computing class (EDSQ)

You are unemployed and in receipt of benefits



You are working and your annual wage is less than £21,255 gross per year (West Yorkshire only)\*

## Free courses for learners aged 19+

*\*West Yorkshire residents only, £18,525 for residents in other non-devolved areas.*

Depending on your circumstances, many of our courses and course levels can be accessed for free.

Free English, maths and digital skills tuition is available for adults who don't already have a GCSE grade 4 (previous grade C) or Level 2 qualification in the subject. You may also be eligible for free tuition if you are studying your first full Level 2 or Level 3 qualification - subject to status and course.

Don't hesitate to get in touch to find out what fee support you could receive and what evidence you may need to provide. Even if you don't meet the criteria, you might be able to get financial assistance through our Learner Support Funds and Student Life team.

### Community Learning (CL) Course Fees

### Level 3 Free Courses for Jobs

As part of the government's Free Courses for Jobs programme, over 400 Level 3 qualifications are now available for free study. This means that if you don't already hold a Level 3 qualification (such as an A Level or equivalent), you can gain valuable new skills - regardless of your age, location, and background.

### Level 3+ Courses for 19+ Learners

You may be eligible for free tuition if you are aged 19-23, don't have an existing Level 3 qualification, and plan to study a Level 3 course. This includes CACHE or BTEC courses, A Levels and professional qualifications. Eligibility depends on any qualifications you currently hold and the course level you have chosen. Full fees are payable, regardless of personal circumstances, if:

- You are over 19 and have an existing Level 3 qualification
- You are over 24, haven't previously studied at Level 3, and the course is unavailable through Free Courses for Jobs

### Advanced Learner Loans

When fees are due, our Advanced Learner Loan can help cover part or all of the costs so that you can focus on your studies.

You can apply for an Advanced Learner Loan if you are:

**Aged 19 or over**

**A UK resident**

**Accepted on to an eligible course at Level 3**

Once you have confirmed your course offer and received our learning and funding information letter, you can register and apply for a loan online. You can borrow a minimum of £300, while the maximum amount depends on your chosen course fees. Before enrolling, you need to confirm an approved Advanced Learner Loan. If you don't, you will need to discuss your options with us.

You do not need to pay your loan back until:

**You have finished your course**

**You earn more than £25,000 per annum**

Our loan repayment is as manageable as possible, on a 30 year, low-rate term. Plus, if you get a loan to cover tuition fees for an Access to HE course and go on to study a degree, your loan will be written off. Bursaries may be available. ### Instalment Plan

If you decide against an approved Advanced Learner Loan, or your course is not eligible for other funding, you could pay using an instalment plan for any course fee over £100.

You will pay 25% of your course fees at enrolment; the remainder will then be spread between one and six months, depending on your requirements and course length. ### Financial Support

Don't let money worries stop your ambitions; we can help you overcome financial barriers outside of course fees.

Our 19+ Discretionary Learner Support (DLS) and an Advanced Learner Loan bursary can help with travel, meals and childcare costs. They can also ease course-related costs such as equipment, protective clothing, specialist books and educational visits.

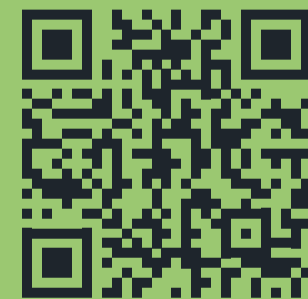
