The role includes colour matching and working to manufacturer specifications. Work usually takes place within a repair workshop, under the supervision of a fully qualified Paint Technician. The role involves following defined processes and demonstrating the understanding of spray painting technology, paint composition and the various methods of spray painting vehicles.
