3. Invitation to interview

Our Admissions team will invite you to book an interview.

4. Interview

You will be given information about your course and, depending on the entry requirements, you may be asked to complete an assessment. We can also talk to you about your support needs.

5. Offer

If you are successful, we will offer you a place on the course.

6. Enrolment

You will be invited into college to enrol.

7. Waiting List

You may be placed on a waiting list until there is space on a course, or until a new course starts.

8. Enrol The final step!

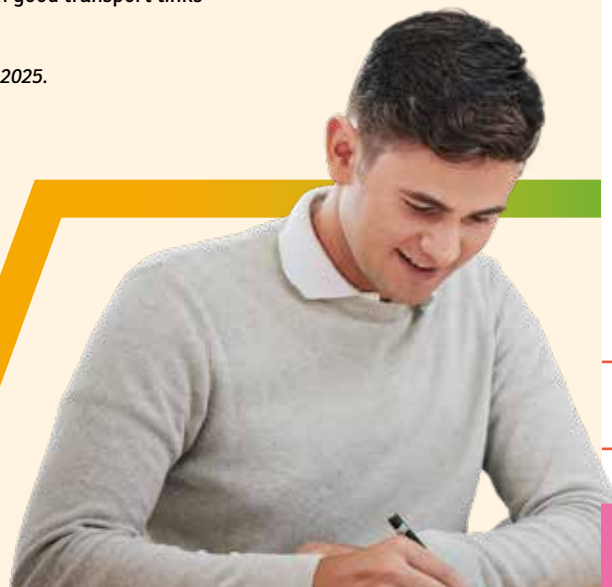
